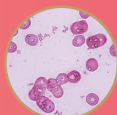

Haemophilus: Can cause pink eye



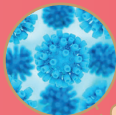
E.Coli: Causes food poisoning & diarrhoea



Streptococci: Gives sore throat



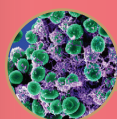
Hepatitis A: Causes jaundice and diarrhoea



Shigella: Causes diarrhoea



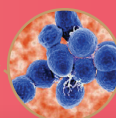
Staphylococcus: Causes zit & boil

## HOW TO WASH YOUR HANDS?



Wet hands with water.



Apply soap.



Rub hands palms to palms.



Rub the back of each hand with fingers interlaced.



Rub palms together with fingers interlaced.



Rub with back of fingers to the opposing palms.



Rub each thumb clasped in opposite hands.



Rub the tips of fingers.



Rub each wrist with different hands.



Rinse with water.



Dry thoroughly your hands.



Your hands are now clean.
